

## *TROOP 65* FLAG RAISING AND GREETING DUTY FOR L.V.C.C.

LAKWOOD VILLAGE COMMUNITY CHURCH, AS OUR SPONSOR OR CHARTERED ORGANIZATION, IS VERY SUPPORTIVE OF TROOP 65. SOME OF THE MANY WAYS THAT L.V.C.C. SHOWS THEIR SUPPORT INCLUDES ALLOWING THE USE OF THEIR FACILITIES, PROVIDING FOR AN ACTIVE REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE CHURCH MEMBERSHIP TO BE INVOLVED IN OUR TROOP COMMITTEE (USUALLY A CURRENT OR FORMER SCOUTER), ASSISTING THE TROOP WITH ADDITIONAL FUNDS IF NECESSARY TO ALLOW ANY SCOUT TO ATTEND OUTINGS REGARDLESS OF FINANCIAL ABILITY TO PAY, AND AS A SOURCE OF EAGLE PROJECTS.

OUT OF RESPECT FOR THEIR GENEROSITY AND TO CONTINUE TO FOSTER A CLOSE RELATIONSHIP WITH L.V.C.C., TROOP 65 SCOUTS AND CREW MEMBERS RAISE AND TAKE DOWN THE FLAG AT THE CHURCH EACH SUNDAY. AS THIS OCCASIONALLY DOES NOT OCCUR, THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES ARE TO BE ADHERED TO:

- 1) There is a posted Duty Roster on the Bulletin Board in the basement, which is also in the possession of each Patrol / Crew Leader and available on-line; which designates the responsible party for each month.
- 2) Patrol / Crew leader of the group having responsibility for any given month will discuss with said group this obligation and assign Scouts to perform this duty on a specific Sunday.
- 3) Patrol / Crew Leader will provide a list of the Scouts' names and duty date to the Chaplains Aide at the Patrol Leaders Council meeting prior to their group's month of duty.
- 4) Patrol / Crew Leader will ensure that the Flag is raised each Sunday by either being present or having their immediate assistant present each Sunday of the designated month.
- 5) Patrol / Crew Leader will notify the Chaplains Aide that the Flag duty has been completed. Chaplains Aide will note the service in their log book and provide the information to the Troop Scribes at the next P.L.C.

### **Flag Duty "How to"**

Scouts assigned to Flag Duty must arrive at L.V.C.C. by 8:00 A.M. on their assigned Sunday

8:00-8:10 A.M. Arrive at L.V.C.C. and raise the Flag, remembering that the Church flag is at the very top of the pole with the Stars and Stripes just below. Always remember that it is God over Country.

(Flags are stored in the bell tower closet located in front hallway, flags only fit on pole one way)

8:15 – 8:30 A.M. Greet and pass out programs to all people as they enter the sanctuary, smile

11:00 A.M. Return to L.V.C.C. to take down the Flag
